CHRIST CENTERED

If you would describe yourself as someone whose relationship with Christ is the most important relationship in your entire life then life **Christ-centered** is most likely you. To be Christ centered is to see your life as fully surrendered to Jesus and His agenda.

MOVING FORWARD

To move forward in your understanding of and relationship with Jesus it will require intentionally making some choices where you place yourself in a context to be stretched and challenged.



CHRIST CENTERED

Develop a personal relationship with Christ

- Seek out ways to invest in the lives of others. Eg. Mentor someone or serve someone in need.
- Spend time daily reflecting on the Bible and in prayer.
- Reflect on areas of where you need to put God first and trust him. eg, giving, forgiveness, serving.

Understand the Bible in greater depth

- Consider theological study or reading which will increase your understanding of Scripture.
- Seek to share what you are learning in the Bible, either formally through such things as leading a Connect Group or in informal ways.

Get to know church leaders who are committed to growing in their relationship with Jesus

- Seek out Christians who will continue to stretch your thinking and whose faith you admire.
- Let leaders you might not personally meet stretch your faith through books, blogs and podcasts.

Expect be challenged and to grow in your faith

- Consider how you can build into the life of the church.
- Place yourself in environments where you can share your faith and invite others to FFBC.

Take personal responsibility for your own spiritual growth

- Set some personal spiritual goals, such as a Bible reading plan, a plan to serve, books to read, and consider ways in which show the love of God, amongst other things.
- Follow people up during the week, after services or connect groups. We grow through serving and trusting that God will use us.
